



Which proof of ID is valid during an exam?

Only officially valid ID's in the Netherlands are valid.

VALID:

- A valid passport.
- A valid identity card or driver's license, issued by a government agency within the EEA countries *, if provided with a passport photo.
- A valid aliens document or alien card issued by a Dutch government agency.

NOT VALID:

- An identity card or driver's license issued outside the EEA countries *.
- An aliens document or alien card issued in a county other than The Netherlands.

The validity period of an identity document may not have been expired on the exam date.

*** Which countries belong to the European Economic Area (EEA)?**

The European Economic Area (EEA) includes all EU countries plus Liechtenstein, Norway and Iceland:

Austria;	France;	Malta;
Belgium;	Greece;	Netherlands;
Bulgaria;	Hongary;	Norway;
Cyprus;	Ireland;	Poland;
Croatia;	Iceland;	Portugal;
Czech Republic;	Italy;	Romania;

Estonia;	Lithuania;	Spain;
Finland;	Luxembourg;	Sweden.
